- Ireland; The development of a new evangelist role specifically in Ireland, to continue the legacy developed particularly by Roger Murphy. This is a proposed partnership with the Irish church
- Finances; If we are to develop staff and mission opportunities, we need more people to commit to funding. TFM has historically not asked for money on any regular basis. The word Faith in our title remains important. If we are doing what God wants us to do then He will provide. However we cannot just assume people know of the needs if we don't tell them
- Wisdom; For the Trustees as they support and guide the staff

 For the admin team; David Baslington, Denise Frisby, Michael Watts
- For links with other organisations; that we might work better together in sharing the gospel across our nation
