A Message from Tim Hall and Paul Preston

A few months ago it became clear to staff and trustees that TFM would soon require a new office - although there were real physical issues, this news was primarily a revelation from God. A considerable amount of prayer and discussion then took place, and a new and very exciting vision took shape, at the heart of which was a statement that 'TFM doesn't need an office. It needs a **centre**.'

We need to say immediately that this is not about residential training or a retreat centre. TFM is about going out - that's who we are, that's what we do. So this is in addition to all that we already do - for we stop nothing, we merely add to who we are and what we are already doing..

But this would be a centre:

- A centre from which all staff can work;
- A centre that has a new larger office facility because TFM will need to grow.
- And it will be a centre where 10 people can stay – perhaps not luxuriously, but a bed and some food. A centre that is placed in an area where the church is weakest, probably amongst the villages: a place where we can make a difference and learn whilst doing it! So TFM can offer '*a week that will change your life*'- A team of 10 stays with us, and yes there will need to be a little training, but each day they are out – out in a nearby town/village/hamlet — out doing evangelism. And when that team goes home they can do what our teams always do – enthuse others, get stuff going in their home churches and home areas. And they will say 'send us a team for a week!' Which we will answer as we always have...
- A centre that does have prayer at its heart. We are about going out - but we are also about God. So morning/evening prayer will be a part of life there.

Since this vision was born, we have been waiting, waiting happily and peacefully, knowing that in His time, things will happen. And now it appears that time is near - TFM has been asked to vacate its current Coton office by 8th January 2021.

It will be a new year and a new beginning!

So now we ask for your prayers: Rejoice in all that God has given us to do, ask Him to now reveal the next part of His plan and pray for staff and trustees - that we make all the right decisions at all the right times!
